Hint: it's just passed down The Roadside to Paloma. Hidden behind a blue door at the back of a small liquor store, the space gives way to a fashionable after-hours cocktail bar and club, with a distinctive warrior rabbit statue behind the bar. The cocktail menu is a twist on the familiar, each expertly paired with a suggested dish from the food menu. Resident DJs turn up the volume of groovy music after dinner hours, making the perfect place for a late-night drink with a bit of dancing thrown in.As the name suggests, 16MM nods to vintage film STEVEN CHARL16MMStreetside in the heart of Gemmayzeh, this resto-bar is one for intimate evenings and friendly gatherings, with a special nod for cinephiles. Taking its name from film reel, the bar is decorated in black and white with vintage cinema paraphernalia and a projector playing old movie clips on a side wall. The extensive cocktail menu is full of tongue-in-cheek puns from popular film titles, such as Misky Business, Mango Unchained, Sister Sage and Pineapple Express. Dishes like artichoke and spinach dip or Kuzko's quinoa salad are great for sharing.
