KIPP Empower Academy is a renowned charter school in South Los Angeles that offers free education and is part of the national KIPP network. Founded in 2010, it's the first elementary school in KIPP SoCal and serves students in kindergarten to fourth grade. The school focuses on empowering its students to excel academically, physically, and emotionally. To achieve a strong mind, KEA uses a blended learning model that caters to different learning styles. For physical development, the school has a rigorous program including PE, dance, and healthy food options. Culturally-responsive teaching practices help scholars develop emotional intelligence. The school received an award from US News & World Report as one of the Best Elementary Charter Schools in 2025. KIPP Empower Academy is part of KIPP LA Schools, which operates five charter schools serving elementary and middle school students in East and South Los Angeles. Founded in 2003, KIPP LA's mission is to provide academic skills, intellectual habits, and character traits for students to succeed in high school, college, and life. KEA adopted a blended-school model due to budget cuts resulting from California's financial crisis, losing \$200,000 of planned funding. The program uses various online tools, including DreamBox, iStation, and Compass Learning, with a focus on general subjects like math, English language arts, history/social studies, and science. Inside the classroom, students engage in individualized online learning, teacher-led instruction, and collaborative activities through the Station Rotation Model. This approach acknowledges that each student arrives at school with different abilities and needs. KIPP Empower Academy, a public charter school in Los Angeles, offers an extended school day from 7:45AM to 4:15PM, giving students ample time for learning and growth. The school's instructional approach focuses on small, ability-based groups within the classroom, allowing teachers to tailor their instruction to meet each student's unique needs. With computer integration, students can work at their own pace, promoting a more personalized learning experience. Teachers can closely monitor student progress and provide targeted support when needed. Academic results have been impressive, with 97% of kindergarteners demonstrating proficiency in reading on the SAT-10 test. In math, 98% of kindergarteners scored above average, while 91% reached the top quartile. First-grade students also showed strong performance, with 96% and 79% achieving the 50th and 75th percentiles in reading, respectively. The school's commitment to blended learning is expected to contribute to its long-term sustainability as enrollment reaches full capacity by 2015.
