Ed Milan always felt that something was missing from his life. He had grown up in a loving family, that was never in question. But he never knew who his biological father was. And over time it began to eat away at him. My mother met my father when he was a soldier and stationed at Ft. Bliss in El Paso, Texas, the 32-year-old Savanna, Ga. resident said. She had a relationship with him but he moved on before she knew she was pregnant, so he never knew I existed. When Milan finally launched a serious effort to track down his real father he enlisted the help of Spokeo, a Pasadena-based search engine that organizes White Page listings, public records and social media information into easily searchable online profiles to help users quickly find people. Spokeo allowed me to cross-reference a lot of loose ends, said Milan, who works as a real estate agent. They offered the largest amount of public information more than any other medium we were using. And it paid off. Last year Milan connected with his biological father, who lives just four hours away in North Carolina. Now I just have a sense of fulfillment, that's the easiest way to sum it up, he said. Before this I just had a void in my life. I didn't even have a picture or anything to hold onto. And now I also have two half brothers who are pretty cool. It's just amazing. That's exactly the kind of story Spokeo co-founder and CEO Harrison Tang likes to hear. Tang, who founded the company in 2006, said people searches are the second most popular searches behind navigation queries. We call ourselves the universal people search, Tang said. We have access to 600 million historical records and court records. We have addresses, emails, phone numbers, social network profiles, court records and we also have professional business information. So if someone owned a business we'd have a record of that. Spokeo is a perfect vehicle for users who are searching for long-lost friends, relatives or others. And lots of people are looking. Spokeo closed out 2014 with its most successful year ever. The company posted a 159 percent increase in revenue growth between 2012 and 2014 and it now employs 160 people, more than double its staffing from 2012. Ultimately, this works, Tang said. We are among the top three people-search engines out there. We have 18 million visitors each month. Execution is the key. We have court records from so many different courthouses in the U.S. with so many different systems. If you wanted to check all of that you'd normally have to go through thousands of court websites. That would take tens of hours. And that's just one aspect of our service. Spokeo has about 9 billion records in its database and the monthly fee to use the service ranges from \$5 to \$30, depending on how much information someone is looking for. Businesses and law firms use our service to mitigate risk, Tang said. And it's also used for identity verification. When someone is on a social network they can make false claims about who they really are. You can use our service to verify someone's identity. Spokeo also employs the services of Search Angels volunteers who use Spokeo to help those touched by adoption, foster care and other family separations to find long-lost family members while also offering emotional support. Connie Gray is one of the dedicated Search Angels. I've been helping people since I did my own search in 1976, the 56-year-old Texas resident said. It took me two years. But with today's technology it would just take hours. Gray said family members sometimes lose track of each other in the foster care system or because they have simply grown apart. This can be a serious attempt to collect your information leading to fraud, to never click on those links sent to you by text by scammers please make a search and contribute to your community by reporting the numbers looking suspicious. In the meantime, you can contact your bank to make sure no harm is experienced from an accidental click on these texts. Texts are harder for users to avoid as we unintentionally click on links containing harmful viruses in emails and texts since they look similar to genuine texts. The other subjects used to make people click on the scam texts are competition and reward texts. Which simply requires you to text back with answers such as Yes or No, these texts can be easily charged at premium rates by the number texted on your phone. Sometimes the scam is answering questions by texting back and the follow us question arrives respectively to keep you texting back leading to losses and high phone bills. Try avoiding all the unknown numbers sending texts including the texts containing no links. The number I Search doesn't have any Records on the Portal After checking up on a number texted you or called, if no information is obtainable then it is your choice to report the number and share your experience with others to help, exchange information about the number. You can write all the information in relation to the number in the question and make others aware that it is not a recognized number, maybe disturbing you repeatedly or just receiving the call, but no other action was taken by the caller. In any case, all details provided by you will help others to avoid the scam numbers or identify the number to be genuine. There are indications for numbers to be identified such as the time of the call, this is a piece of significant information as mainly scam calls will be made in unsociable hours. How to Identify Scams Missed calls can also be genuine from a business or government department, however, with so many cases being reported continuously in today's technological world it is always best to be cautious. You should always be more careful before making any payments or providing your personal details on the phone. As the cases reported have risen in the recent year's scammers use features to hide the number or even make them appear to be from a genuine number, if in any case, you feel unsure about the caller it is advised to hang up and contact the caller mentioned in the call to check if it was a fraud call. You should note that a genuine call is always reported on the CRM systems and your number time of the call and other details would be registered in genuine calls, however, if you are told no call was recorded to be made to your number then the caller can be identified as potential fraud if you report this incident to your bank also they may be able to take official actions against the scam by advising their other customers to not to answer or give any details to the callers. Is ringing back the number called a good option to find out who called? Most fraud activity and scam payments are generated by callers making a returning call to the unknown, unrecognized number. It is clearly a risky option especially if the number you are calling back is a premium rated number, then you will be listening to recorded messages longer than usual and the focus will be keeping you on the line. Premium numbers usually start with 09, and short numbers starting with numbers 5-8 is also high-risk potential. We also have identified there are some premium rated numbers that are hard to detect since they start with 070 looking similar to a genuine mobile phone line number but the cost associated with calling these numbers will be reflected at high costs on the bills. Some other numbers to be cautious about are 0871, 0872, 0873 and 118 number. The safest option to find out who called you is using the search function on our platform. Also, remember that legitimate companies would contact their customers with also their email addresses and by post with official letters. Although there are also scams on the postal services and emails main tool scammers use is phone calls. If you don't recognise a number, but if it is from a genuine person, they would leave you a voicemail. Therefore, we advise searching the number and looking at its reputation in our community would be the best option to find out who called you from an unrecognized/unknown number.
