What kids' movie do you still secretly watch over and over? Have you ever danced in front of the mirror? Which song are you embarrassed that you love? What is something you've never told anyone? Do you sleep with a blanket or stuffed animal? Given the choice, would you want to hang out with your parents? Imagine yourself as a college student... what would you be like? Truth or Dare Questions for Families Which family member are you most like? Who in your family are you afraid you'll turn out like some day? Who in your family has seen you cry in the last year? Do you choose to hang out with your siblings? What do you and your siblings do when no one else is home? What's the worst thing you've ever said to your parents? What do you parents do that you don't want anyone else to see? Have you ever blamed your sibling for something that was actually your fault? For great dares, the key here is asking the person to do something they wouldn't ordinarily do. This may seem obvious, but it's kind of a different bar for everyone. Really hilarious dares come from absurd requests. Quick Tip Remember that you should never dare a friend to break the law or do something dangerous. The game is supposed to be fun, and the entertainment will quickly come to an end if someone is hurt or the police are called. Good Dares for Your Crush Kiss the feet of the person who gave you this dare. Make up a rap about the person who dared you, mentioning his or her best features. Take a selfie while kissing the other person on the cheek. Talk about what you like about the other person for the next two minutes. See how many maraschino cherry stems you can tie into a knot with your tongue in the space of five minutes. Dares for Tweens Drink a mystery brew concocted by the rest of the group. Make sure there is nothing harmful or dangerous in the concoction and set a reasonable limit of sips the person must take to complete the dare. Go outside and sing a clip of your favorite Disney song at the top of your lungs. Eat a snack without using your hands. Take 10 minutes to come up with an outfit that has every color of the rainbow. Borrow things from friends as you need to. If there is a pet at the event, try to hold the pet for the rest of the night. Eat a mouthful of crackers and try to whistle. In your next class, raise your hand each time the teacher asks a question and give the answer (if you can!). Combine two foods that should never go together, such as pickles and peanut butter or applesauce and olives, and eat a huge bite. Pretend to be a waiter or waitress and take snack orders from everyone in the group. Bring them the food they ordered and then check back to see if they like it. Repeat everything another player says for the next three rounds of the game. Quick Tip If it's okay with everyone involved, it can be fun to get a video of the person doing the dare. It's hilarious to look back on these later. Dares for Couples Stand next to the refrigerator (or food pack if you're camping), close your eyes, and randomly point to something inside. Keep your eyes shut while your boyfriend or girlfriend helps you eat some of the food you picked. Exchange shirts with your significant other for the next round of questions. Try to give your boyfriend or girlfriend a piggyback ride around the room. Allow the other person to give you a whole new look, complete with hair, makeup, and a super awesome outfit. Lick each one of your significant other's fingers. Clean Dares for Truth or Dare Tape your hands to your ankles for the next 10 minutes. Wear a funny hat on your head for the next three rounds of questions. Ask the neighbors to borrow a cup of sugar. Get a large garbage bag and cut the bottom open. Put it on like a skirt and tie the ties around your waist. Act like you are modeling couture on the catwalk. Run around the room imitating a monkey. Dares Over Text Open Facebook and like the first post, whether you agree or not. Share the last photo you took with your phone with no expectation. Moonwalk while a friend takes a video, and then send the video to the person who dared you. Everything you type for the rest of the game has to rhyme. Call the first person on your contact list and sing them happy birthday. Text the fifth person on your contact list that you peed your pants. Funny Dares Crack an egg on your head. Let everyone in the group style your hair and take photos. For the rest of the game, every time someone asks a question, you have to yell "giddy-up" and gallop around the room in a circle. Take off your socks and wear them on your hands for the rest of the evening. Pretend that you're swimming underwater for the next three rounds of questions. Don't forget to make bubbling noises and come up for air from time to time. Sing instead of speaking for the next two rounds of the game. Dares for Adults Take off the couch cushions and hold anything you find under there in your mouth for 10 seconds. Switch clothing with someone of the opposite gender. Change in private, but wear the clothes for the next four rounds. Find something to wear as a cape and act like a superhero. Say the alphabet backward in a British accent. Give a play-by-play of the last time you went into the bathroom, covering every detail. Go to the drugstore and buy a package of adult diapers. Hold hands with the person to your right for 60 seconds. Call someone you think is attractive and pay that person a compliment about his or her best feature. Do a belly dance for the group. Games like Truth or Dare can be loads of fun. However, if you come across something that you or someone in the group doesn't want to answer or do, don't get swept up in the game. Present that person with another truth question or dare to keep the game going or maybe move on to something simpler like asking yes or no questions.
