The Game's Characters and Mechanics ##### School Staff and Students \* The headmaster, The Thing, enforces school rules with minimal expression of emotion. \* Mrs. Pomp, a professor, requires punctuality for her lessons; late arrivals result in her becoming agitated and pursuing the student herself. ##### Environmentally Influential Characters \* Gotta Sweep, resembling a broomstick, rapidly propels characters at high speeds. \* First Prize, a friendly robot with bandaged arms, gently pushes players around while proclaiming affection for hugs. \* Chalkies, appearing on chalkboards and rotating within the classroom, lures Baldi's attention by making creepy sounds, temporarily preventing escape. ##### Obstacles to Overcome \* Beans slows down players by spitting chewing gum globules at them. \* Cloudy Coper creates wind tunnels through hallways, influencing players' speed depending on their direction. \* The Test features a floating head that reattaches briefly when turned off, temporarily blinding players. ##### Interactive Objects and Items \* Alarm clocks draw the disciplinarian's attention \* Energy-flavored zesty bars replenish stamina at Baldies Cafe \* Soda can knock enemies back \* Scissors cut various objects \* WD-NoSquee prevents villain attacks \* Yellow door locks block certain passages temporarily \* Principal's keys allow access to any room \* Quarters buy snacks and sodas \* Anti-hearing and disorienting tape renders Baldi plush, deaf, and blind ##### Gameplay Controls \* WASD keys for movement and strafing \* Mouse for looking around \* Shift key for short periods of running \* Space bar for quick look-behind functionality \* Left-click for gathering items and interacting with the environment Magic Cat Academy game returns to Google's Halloween Doodle, this time with an astronaut helmet-wearing Momo battling ghosts in space. The game is described as Momo embarking on an "out of this world adventure" against her arch nemesis Marshmallow the ghost. Players can help Momo obliterate ghosts and creatures by drawing its symbol anywhere in the frame.
