If this is the only Google account on your Samsung phone, then you will be asked to enter your phone's current lock screen password/PIN/pattern, if any, to confirm the deletion. Way 2: Remove Google account from Samsung phone remotely If you are in the case where someone else's Google account is logged into your phone and you can't remove it from your phone's Settings, try a remote deletion. What you need to do is get in touch with the owner of the Google account and ask him to do the following. Step 1: Sign in to the Google account from any web browser on the computer and go to the page . Step 2: The page shows all the devices on which the Google account is currently signed in. Click the Samsung phone from which you want to remove the Google account. Step 3: On the next page, click Sign out and click Sign out again, so that the Google account will be disconnected from your Samsung phone. Way 3: Remove Google account without password using Android Password Refixer If for some reason you can't remove your Google account from your phone's settings or elsewhere, iSumssoft Android Password Refixer will help.
