The events continue on Saturday and, as is typical, will conclude on Sunday with the final All-Star Game. This year, however, the NBA made a significant change to the format of the game. The NBA's "mini-tournament" format for the 2025 All-Star Game isn't the past, the NBA All-Star game was always just one 48-minute game between the Eastern Conference and Western Conference with teams chosen by the leading vote-getters. Last year, the NBA returned to an East vs West game. That format ended in a 397-point affair that was widely criticized. So this year, the NBA is introducing a brand new, four-team mini-tournament to be played at the Golden State Warriors' Chase Center this Sunday.Three teams of NBA All-Stars, plus the winner of the annual Rising Stars challenge will make up the four teams. Charles Barkley, Shaquille O'Neal, and Kenny Smith are the honorary coaches of the three NBA All-Star teams and chose their players earlier in February. The Rising Stars team will be coached by TNT analyst and WNBA legend Candace Parker, and we'll know her roster by the end of the night tonight at the conclusion of the Rising Stars Challenge.Meet the future legends: These are the 2025 NBA All-Star Rising Stars Game rostersHow it worksThe Rising Stars Challenge, which will be played as a four-team tournament as well, will take place tonight at 9 p.m. ET. It will feature the league's best rookies and sophomores plus seven players from the G League. The winner of that tournament comprises the fourth team to play in the NBA All-Star Game this Sunday, February 16.Each of the four NBA All-Star teams will have eight players (24 total), the same as in previous years. In the mini-tournament, Kenny's Young Stars will face Chuck's Global Stars in the first semifinal (Game 1), and Shaq's OG's will play Candace's Rising Stars in the second semifinal (Game 2). Then, the winner of Game 1 will play the winner of Game 2 in the championship (Game 3). The prize pool is \$1.8 million this year, with the winning team's players to receive \$125,000 each. The runners up will receive \$50,000 each, and the losing teams' players will receive \$25,000 each.Why the change?For several years now, NBA Commissioner Adam Silver has been trying to find ways to make the All-Star event more competitive. It's difficult, as there's nothing really at stake and it's a bit of a fun break for the players, despite their being money involved (which is an incentive for the players, but not the fans). After last year's game saw the teams score 211 and 186 points in Indianapolis, Silver heard the criticism and made a change. "I think everyone was disappointed in what they saw last year," Silver said back in November. "It wasn't just the league, it was the players, as well as the players association. I think we all did what we thought we could, thinking we would - particularly in Indiana, sort of the heartland of basketball - somehow we would give it the college try, and we'd see a more competitive game.""We all want to do a better job providing competition and entertainment for our fans."Thus, this new format was born as a way of trying to "excite the fans and also excite the players, so it's something they're enthusiastic about participating in". The NBA insists that putting competitive athletes in a competitive situation will guarantee they show up and play hard. We will have to see this weekend. But the shorter game with a 40-point score limit will definitely help things along. When Does It Start and How To Watch In short, the Rising Stars game features NBA players exclusively in their rookie or sophomore year in the NBA competing against each other. It used to be rookies vs. sophomores, but the rosters were changed to include both rookies and sophomores. In recent years, they have also included NBA G League players in the event to turn it into a tournament instead of one game. The Rising Stars game starts at 9:00 pm Eastern Time. How Is the Rising Stars Game Formatted? The tournament will have two rounds, two semifinal games and one final. Whoever wins the semifinals advances to the finals, and whoever wins the finals will face off with the NBA's All-Stars during the 2025 All-Star Game tournament on Sunday, Feb. 16 as part of a team headlined by Candace Parker. The semifinals games are first to 25, and the finals are first to 25. The NBA Rising Stars challenge has taken on different looks over recent years. From a USA vs. World format to the current four-team round robin form, the NBA has tinkered with the Rising Stars game year over year. However, what doesn't change is the fact that the NBA is laden with young stars, ready to showcase their skills in the spotlight. This year, the winning team in the Rising Stars Challenge will join the NBA All-Star Game as part of the four-team tournament debuting this year.
